The City of Toronto is made up of six boroughs, has a population of 2.82 million and is the fourth largest city in North America.

Toronto contributes nearly 18.5% of Canada's annual GDP with a \$332B CD economy in 2018. Toronto GTA construction 2019 is forecasted to be \$39 billion. Toronto GTA number of construction projects (including high-rise residential but not single-family) in 2019 is forecasted to be 2,900.

With over 38% of the headquarters located in Toronto, the Greater Toronto Area has been the preferred location for many leading national and international financial, architectural, engineering, building companies, and manufacturers. Toronto has ranked highly in quality of living to attract immigration and a highly educated workforce which makes it easy for the over 216,000 businesses to operate, attract and retain its highly skilled, multilingual workforce of 1.4 million.

Please note we will require up to 10 business days to process the Letter of Invitation in a timely manner. Do not travel to Canada, or make travel arrangements, without proper entry documentation.
